CHECKLIST: WELL PREPARED FOR YOUR JOURNEY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR JOURNEY AT-A-GLANCE

Entry requirements Please familiarise yourself with the general entry requirements (e.g. passport and visa) as well as the necessary Corona entry documents (e.g. proof of vaccination or test certificates). Please check whether you meet the requirements for your destination, transit country and return journey. Simply enter your departure and destination airport at the following link. > View entry regulations
Vaccination Being vaccinated against Covid-19 can make your journey considerably easier. Make sure you have your vaccination certificate on you at all times and check whether further vaccinations are required for your destination.
Digital vaccination certificate If you have a digital vaccination certificate, keep it on you at all times.
Save documents in the Lufthansa app Save your Covid-19 travel documents such as your digital vaccination certificate in the "Personal data Entry data" section of the Lufthansa app and save time during your next mobile check-in. Your data is stored locally on your mobile device, can then be checked automatically – and your boarding pass is issued.
Information about Corona testing Find out about the testing possibilities at your destination and the requirements concerning the test result. You may have to be tested both before your outbound journey and before your return journey. > Information about Covid-19 tests
Booking your Corona test On the day of travel, make your way to your flight in a relaxed manner and prebook a test for your travel in advance. > Book your Covid-19 test
Corona-related travel documents Check which corona-related documents are required for your destination (e.g. negative test result, vaccination certificate, DEA, or others).
Digital document check Have your corona-related documents checked in advance on selected routes. This way you will know early on if your documents are complete and correct and can confirm this to us when you check-in online or from your mobile device

Face mask requirement You are still obliged to wear a face mask on all Lufthansa Group flights. Pack your personal protection items and toiletries, such as extra face masks, sanitiser etc., in your carry-on baggage. On longer flights, make sure you have several face masks with you and observe the allowance for liquids in carry-on baggage (max. 100 ml).

Digital self-services Ideally, use our digital self-service options and plan enough time at the airport.
Apps Download the apps of the Lufthansa Group airlines and stay informed at all times. Keep your contact details up-to-date in case we have to contact you.
GOOD TO KNOW
 It's not only the entry requirements that can differ depending on your destination country. Different regulations may also apply to your connecting flight. Obtain information from all the airlines you are travelling with.
 Increased checks can lead to longer waiting times at the airport. Find out in advance by consulting your departure airport's website and allow more time than usual for departure and after landing.
